Welcome to the PTP Tournament Training Camp at Princeton University, **with week 1 (June 25-29) being held at Community Park, Princeton.** Juniors welcome to attend this camp are those that are current participants of PTP's Tournament Training program or have tried out and been approved by Alex Armstrong, PTP Tournament Training Director.

Please read the following guidelines and procedures, so that we may provide a happy and safe camp experience for your child.

Registration: For each week of camp that they attend, campers must be registered and paid in full, prior to the start of camp on Monday. This is necessary to ensure that we have proper staffing and facilities available. Please register online via your Club Automation account.

LATE CHARGE: \$20 – You must register for camp by Thursday to avoid this charge. The charge will be assessed for anyone registering for camp on Friday, Saturday or Sunday for the following week.

**Changes in camp weeks may be subject to \$10 processing fee.*

PU Drop off/pickup: Camp is held at the Pagoda Courts on the Princeton University campus. DROP OFF only in LOTS 15 & 17. DO NOT park in these lots. If you will be getting out of your car, you may park in LOT 23.

Inclement weather back-up Eve Kraft Community Tennis Center at 92 Washington Road.

Week 1 will be held at Community Park, Princeton (362 John St., Princeton – courts located behind the Community Park Elementary School).

If campers must leave early, a written permission slip must be given to the camp director. Please inform the director when dropping your child off if there will be someone other than yourself picking up your child, with that person's name.

Campers are not allowed to be dropped off in the morning before 8:30am.

WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR CAMPERS LEFT OFF BEFORE 8:30am.

PU Directions: Enter the PU campus via the Faculty Road traffic circle. Continue up the university entrance to the second traffic circle and bear right. You will see signs that indicate “tennis courts”. The first set of courts you will see on your left are the Lentz Center courts. Continue past the Lentz Center to the next set of courts. There is no after-camp supervision. If you are going to be late, please make sure your child knows what to do or where to wait for you.

Camp Director: Campers are invited by Alex Armstrong, Director of PTP Tournament Training and will be coached by an outstanding group of tennis professionals. Our staff is second to none and is excited to make this the best tennis experience possible for each camper.

Emergency Contact: Please complete the attached emergency contact/medical form and leave with the director upon signing your child in on Monday. Your cell phone number and the number of an emergency contact, in case you can't be reached, will only be used in case of an emergency.

Lunch and Beverage Breaks: Campers are welcome to bring lunch (no refrigeration on site) or can purchase lunch at Wawa located on University Place. Lunch break is usually 12:00noon –1:00pm. Beverage breaks will be held often and campers are strongly encouraged to bring water with them. **No gum allowed.** Campers are to be supervised at all times. Damage to Princeton University property will be the responsibility of the parent. PTP and Princeton University are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

****When camp is held at Community Park or KCTC , PTP advises that the camper bring their lunch as they will not have the opportunity to walk to an establishment to purchase lunch.***

Health Information: Please inform the director of any health issues or physical limitations your child has that may affect them while at camp. Please include this information on the emergency contact/medical form. This information will be kept strictly confidential.

Behavior: Campers are expected to behave in a courteous and respectful manner at all times. Campers who continually show disrespect to others or break the camp rules will be asked to leave camp without a refund.

Camp T-Shirts: Each camper will receive a PTP camp T-shirt; campers will receive one T-shirt per summer, regardless of how many weeks they attend.

Inclement Weather: In the event of inclement or questionable weather, please call the PTP Hotline at **609-520-0015x2**. A message will be left 30 minutes prior to the start of camp. Camp will not be cancelled. If necessary the tournament training camp will be moved indoors to the Eve Kraft Community Tennis Ctr. (KCTC), 92 Washington Rd., Princeton Jct 08550. Please be sure to call the hotline if you are uncertain of conditions. If camp is relocated to the indoor center during the course of the day please be sure to complete the attached “waiver” allowing PTP staff to transport your child from PU to KCTC>

Make-up policy: There are no make-ups for personal absences. Make-ups will be offered only if camp is cancelled due to inclement weather. There are **NO REFUNDS**.
